A RESOLUTION

FOR

THE REJECTION OF THE CALYPSO DEEPWATER PORT AND PIPELINE PROJECT

Resolution presented by the Board of Directors of Plaza South Condominium

CONSIDERING:

That Plaza South is a Private Condominium located at the edge of the ocean at 4280 Galt Ocean Drive in Fort Lauderdale;

That the Calypso Project includes untested and hazardous elements including a mammoth storage and processing facility for Liquefied Natural Gas to be located ten miles directly east of Plaza South, and a projected arrival bi-weekly of gigantic Tankers each of which will carry large amounts of Liquefied Natural Gas;

That Liquefied Natural Gas is highly flammable, and explosive given certain conditions;

That, although the sponsor insists that Deepwater Ports are safe, the sponsor admits in its literature that in fact there is only one Deepwater Port in operation in the entire world, in Mexico. In other words, we will be Guinea Pigs for what amounts to a test of Deepwater Ports;

That the possibility of industrial accidents and terrorist strikes are unfortunate facts of life and that an accident or terrorist strike could have catastrophic consequences for residents in our condominium and for other residents of our extended community;

That we oppose Calypso for other reasons including but not limited to its potential for damage to our environment and for its possible negative impact on our economy with or without any natural or man-made disaster;

That Calypso will increase our reliance on foreign fossil fuels at a time when we should be striving to cut down or eliminate them and to replace them with other energy sources.

IT IS RESOLVED:

- That we, the Board of Directors of Plaza South, oppose the construction of the Calypso Deepwater Port and Pipeline.
- 2. That the Federal Government should not approve the construction of the Calypso Deepwater Port and Pipeline.
- 3. That, in the event of approval of this project by the Federal Government, Charlie Crist, Governor of the State of Florida, should not approve construction of the Calypso Deepwater Port and Pipeline.
